The Association receives income from an endowment held and managed by Trinity Hall on its behalf, in line with distributions to other funds held by the college, and based on actual income within the overall fund over a rolling period of several years. Quarterly payments of £2,500 are made by Trinity Hall to the Association during the year, with the difference between the amounts paid and the income declared taken to the current account between the two organisations.

**3. THA Awards**

The THA Awards, initiated in 2008, provide a subsidy to current students towards the costs of humanitarian or community vacation projects in the UK or overseas; applications are invited in January each year and Awards made in late March. The committee decides on the funds to be applied for this purpose taking into account the finances for the year in question and the amounts recommended in respect of applications received.

For 2014-15 funding of £4,500 was originally awarded, however the earthquake in Nepal resulted in one of the planned trips being cancelled.

**4. Exceptional legal costs**

The 2013-14 accounts included the release of a provision that had previously been made but that was no longer required; that provision related to costs initially expected to be incurred by Trinity Hall on behalf of it and the Association in dealing with a matter relating to one of the Association's members.
