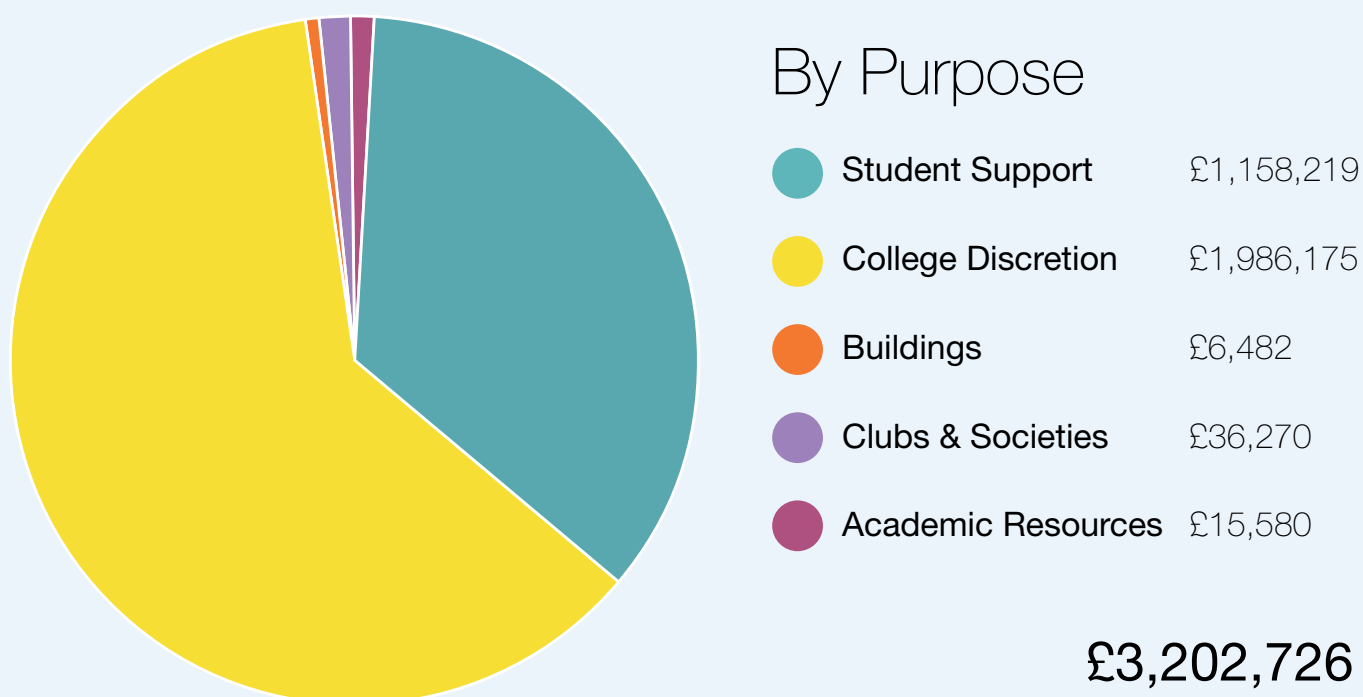

### Breakdown of Gift Income Received

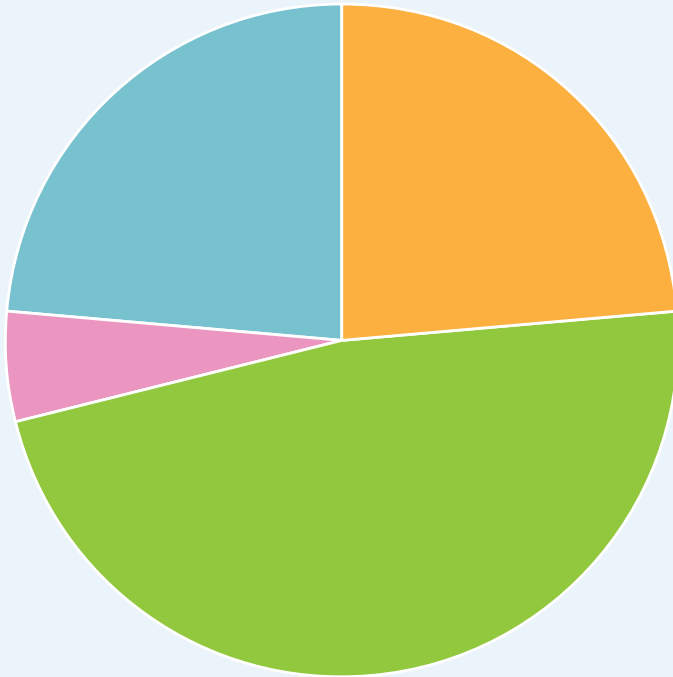

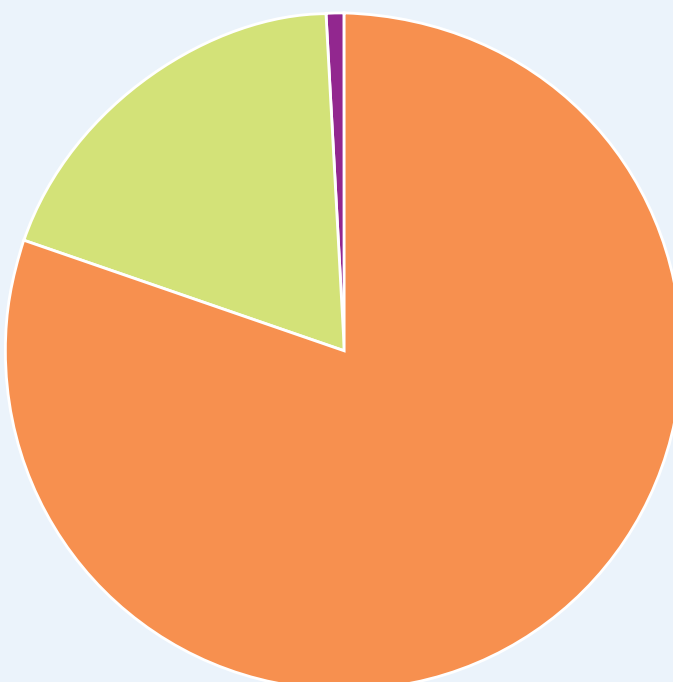

# The Annual Fund and Telethon

---

The Annual Fund, of which the Telephone Campaign is part, helps make a difference to every student's College experience.

Thank you for your support which has helped ensure that we remain competitive, attracting the best students and academics, and that no student is unable to attend or participate in College life because of financial circumstances.

The late Dennis Avery (Trinity Hall, 1980) was called for the first time by a law student in 2012:

“Our chat was as rewarding as it was also refreshing. This is a wonderful program of outreach and staying in touch.”

## Telephone Campaigns

Telephone Campaigns have been running in Cambridge for at least thirteen years. Trinity Hall held its first Telephone Campaign in 2004 and has since run nine campaigns, which in total have raised almost £2 million.

They have had a huge impact on the College and its community. Funds raised have been used to help alleviate student hardship by providing bursaries, studentships and awards. They have also enabled us to undertake refurbishment projects on central site and improve the resources available for the student community.

## Telephone Campaign 2013

In April 2013, just after Easter, sixteen students returned to College to help the Alumni & Development Office contact alumni, inform them of the latest news, seek feedback and ask for support for the College's Annual Fund. The students enjoyed speaking to members on College issues and also gained useful and interesting insights into the variety of career paths which Trinity Hall graduates have taken.

Around 800 alumni were contacted with over half generously donating raising a total of £312,947.

## The Aula Bar

Thanks to the Annual Fund, The Aula Bar was reappointed with new furniture and a new colour scheme and lighting over the summer. Not only is this a lively College bar, but a sociable café during the day, where students, staff and alumni can meet informally and enjoy light refreshments.

## Tax-Effective Giving

### British Tax Payers

#### The Gift Aid Scheme

If you sign a Gift Aid Declaration when making a donation, Trinity Hall can reclaim the basic rate income tax which you have paid from the Inland Revenue. This brings the College an extra 25% at no additional cost to you. Higher rate tax payers can claim back the difference between the basic and higher rate of tax on the total value of the gift.

To claim Gift Aid on donations you must pay UK income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax equal to or greater than the tax the charity reclaims on your donation in the tax year. You can cancel a Gift Aid Declaration at any time by contacting the Development Office.

#### Gift of Shares

Gifts of Shares provide additional benefits to both basic and higher rate tax-payers and have become one of the most tax-efficient ways of giving. The number and value of shares that can be donated is not limited or restricted. Gifts of Shares to a charity are also free from liability to Capital Gains Tax. Gifts of Shares allow the donor to deduct from that year's taxable income not only the market value of the investments at the date of the gift to the charity, but also any incidental costs incurred in transferring the investments, such as broker's fees, less any proceeds or benefits the donor receives in consequence of the gift.

#### A Legacy Bequest

A gift to Trinity Hall in your Will is also exempt from Inheritance Tax. From April 2011, if you leave 10% of your net estate to a charity, such as Trinity Hall, your Inheritance Tax rate can be reduced from 40% to 36%.

### Overseas

#### Europe

The system known as "Transnational Giving Europe" is run by the Charities Aid Foundation and its partners and enables donors to make a gift to the Hall and receive all applicable tax benefits in the country where tax is paid.

To make a transnational gift, please contact your national foundation. It would also be helpful if you could inform the Development Office so that we can ensure all the necessary paperwork is complete.

#### USA
