



## Undergraduate Accommodation Information

Undergraduate accommodation for first-year undergraduate students is currently categorised as follows:

### Central Site:

Bands A - D (c.9 rooms)	Standard Single	£128.15 - £148.35 per week

The accommodation is located on Central Site and WYNG Gardens. Both are within a few minutes' walk of central Cambridge, College facilities, and a number of University libraries, departments, and faculties. The prices above correspond broadly with the size of the room but also take into account other factors such as outlook, proximity to facilities, etc.

Standard single rooms, which are located on Central Site, are fully furnished, with a single bed in most rooms (there are some rooms in bands O – Q with double beds), desk and chair, desk lamp, bookcase or shelves, at least one armchair or couch, and washbasin. There are shared bathroom facilities on each staircase, together with basic kitchen facilities, i.e. a fridge and the use of a kettle and microwave. The single set is also located on Central Site and this consists of a large sitting room/study with a separate bedroom.

Single ensuite rooms, which are located at WYNG Gardens on Thompson's Lane, are fully furnished, with a double bed in most rooms (for single occupancy only), desk and chair, desk lamp, bookcase or shelves, at least one armchair, and ensuite bathroom facilities. These rooms also have access to shared kitchens, including oven, hob, fridge, and microwave, so are ideal for those who wish to self-cater.

Meals are available to all students every day of the week in the College cafeteria during term time only. Vegetarian and vegan options are always available, and menus clearly show the 14 most common allergens (please feel free to ask a member of the catering staff for advice if you have a particular dietary requirement). All College rooms have both a wired and wireless connection to the University Data Network (CUDN), and to the Internet via the University's connection to the Janet Network. The College IT Department will be able to advise you about connecting your computer or other devices, and further information will be included in the First Years' Pack that will be sent to you in September.

Please be aware that the difference in weekly rent between the bands is considerable, and if you anticipate living to a strict budget during your first year, please take this fact into account when choosing the category within which your room will be allocated. Rents include the cost of overhead or fixed lighting, internet access, background central heating in winter, hot and cold water, and housekeeping.

First-year undergraduate students rent their rooms during term time only\*, which amounts to around 30 weeks in total in a typical year. During the holidays, you will need to remove your belongings from your room so that it may be used for admissions and conference events.

\*International and care-experienced students can request an Academic Year licence (which covers the Christmas and Easter holidays) or an Easter licence (which covers the Easter holidays only) if preferred. Please note that you may be asked to move temporarily to a different room on any of our sites during the holiday periods (in particular, note that rooms in WYNG Gardens may not be used during the vacations).

If you have any specific accommodation requirements (e.g. for medical or disability reasons) please specify on the form and we will do our best to accommodate these.

We hope that this information will help you in deciding which type of room you would prefer. We will do our best to comply, but please bear in mind that demand does not always match supply. The approximate number of rooms in each category is given above in brackets.
