Those who sign up for the You'll Fit In programme will be able to participate in online webinars that will offer advice about all aspects of the Cambridge Admissions process, and they will also have the opportunity to chat to current undergraduates to hear more about Cambridge from their perspective. The webinars series consists of the following:

Webinar	Dates	Content
Launch	15 th December 18:00-19:00	An introduction to the programme and the timeline for university applications in October 2026. Parents and supporters are strongly encouraged to attend alongside applicants as they will also have the opportunity for Q&A.
An Introduction to Cambridge University	9 th January 17:00-18:00	Explains Cambridge and how it differs from many universities; what Colleges are and how you might choose one; what Faculties/ Departments are; advice on researching university courses; a chance to ask current undergraduates about how they made their choices.
Meet a Humanities student	20 th January 17:00-18:00	Students from both Arts and Humanities faculties will join us to discuss their experience of Cambridge teaching and learning.
Meet a STEM student	23 rd January 17:00-18:00	Students from Science faculties will join us to discuss their experience of Cambridge teaching and learning.
Super-curricular Engagement	13 th February 17:00-18:00	Advice about super-curriculars vs extra-curriculars, where to start; discussion of how super-curriculars support your application.
Q&A for parents and supporters	20 th Feb 18:00-19:00	Parents and supporters are invited to attend and discuss the issues they are concerned about regarding both the application process and their child attending Cambridge if they receive an offer.
Personal and financial support	10 th March 16:30-17:30	Discussion of support for student wellbeing at the University. Discussion of student loans,

		bursaries, and other sources of funding. Discussion on costs of living in Cambridge. Discussion of options for those who want to avoid Riba.
Personal Statements	17 th April 17:00-18:00	What the Personal Statement is, and how it should be structured; the importance of including super-curriculars and practical tips on how to start. Brief discussion of My Cambridge Application and how to fill it in.
Cambridge and Identity	21 st April 17:00-18:00	Student ambassadors will discuss their experience as members of the University outside of their academic work and how it intersects with their identity.
Admissions Assessments	26 th June 17:00-18:00	Why and how we use Admissions Assessments; deadlines for early registration; how to prepare [this webinar would only be for those participants who must take admissions assessments].
Interviews and Conclusion	24 th July 17:00-18:00	Advice about the interviews, what to expect, and how to prepare; student ambassadors will share some of their interview experiences; this will be the final webinar in the series.
