## Support for Students with Disabilities

The College and the University work together to offer the maximum possible support to all disabled students. Now that you have received an offer (whether conditional or unconditional), we would like to give you a further opportunity to let us know if you have a disability, neurodiverse condition, mental health condition or long-term health condition and if you will require any support or advice when you come to Cambridge.\*

We recognize that some offer holders may feel uncertain about disclosing a disability, neurodiverse condition, mental health condition or long-term health condition. We would like to assure you that any disclosure will in no way adversely affect your offer (although the offer may, of course, still be subject to other conditions, such as academic achievement).

The earlier that we are aware of any condition, the better we are able to ensure that all the arrangements you require are in place before you start here (e.g. specialist study skills support, specialist mentoring, access requirements and exam access arrangements). You may also find that you are eligible for Disabled Students' Allowances (DSAs) or other available funding to support your requirements.

Like all the Colleges at Cambridge, we work in close cooperation with the Accessibility and Disability Resource Centre (ADRC). Their dedicated team of experts provide support, advice and guidance for disabled students and students with specific learning difficulties. With your permission, our College staff can liaise with them to start the process to create a support plan that meets your requirements.
