

FEES AND COSTS FOR UNDERGRADUATES – 2026 ENTRY

This document summarizes the costs for the first year of the degree, if starting in 2026.

University Tuition Fees

Your offer letter should have stated whether you are a 'Home' or 'Overseas' student for fee purposes.

College Fees

Home students who are studying for their first undergraduate degree and are eligible for public funding do not have to pay the College Fee.

All other students (including Overseas and Affiliated students, and any other students who are not eligible for public funding) are required to pay the College Fee as follows:

Trinity Hall £13,245 for the academic year 2026-27

Maintenance Costs

All students will require a reasonable amount of money to pay for rent, food and other various [living costs](#). This amount will be higher for students travelling to Cambridge from overseas.

Most students will only be in Cambridge during term time (approximately 9 months). If you want to stay in Cambridge during vacations, you should budget for the full year. The estimated cost of living in Cambridge for a month in 2026-27 is £1,305. The full amount for the first year would be:

In Cambridge during term time only	£11,745
In Cambridge all year round	£15,660

These figures include certain college charges such as room rent (as a rough guide, first-year undergraduate [accommodation](#) in 2025-26 ranges between £128.15 and £249.50 per week, depending on the size and location of the room). Rents are subject to increase each year.

FOUR-YEAR COURSES

The following courses are either of four years' duration or have options that involve a fourth year:

- Asian & Middle Eastern Studies
- Chemical Engineering & Biotechnology
- Classics 4-year course
- Computer Science
- Engineering
- History & Modern Languages
- Mathematics
- Modern & Medieval Languages
- Natural Sciences

If you are taking one of these courses, you should ensure that you have sufficient funds for all four years of your course. If you are applying for a student loan, you should state that your course is four years in length.

If you are taking one of these courses, you should ensure that you have sufficient funds to complete all six years of the course.
